Abstract

Scopo della LG è fornire raccomandazioni basate su prove di efficacia per una serie di aspetti del trattamento delle Fratture del femore prossimale - FFP nell'anziano; l'aderenza alle raccomandazioni può portare a un miglioramento dei risultati per il paziente e più globalmente a fornire un'assistenza economicamente vantaggiosa. La LG può inoltre rappresentare la base di evidenze scientifiche a supporto dello sviluppo di protocolli diagnostico-terapeutici assistenziali a livello locale. Il documento è stato elaborato adattando al contesto nazionale italiano la LG redatta dal National Institute for Health and Care Excellence (NICE) nel 2011 e aggiornata nel 2019. Complessivamente, la LG fornisce raccomandazioni in merito al trattamento dell'anziano con frattura del femore ed è concepita per seguire l'intero percorso ospedaliero del paziente con frattura nelle fasi pre-, peri- e postoperatorie. All'interno del testo, nella sezione di appartenenza, sono espressi i quesiti clinici ai quali la LG intende rispondere. Vengono fornite raccomandazioni in merito a: diagnostica per immagini nelle fratture occulte del femore, tempo di attesa prima dell'intervento, gestione del dolore, anestesia, livello di esperienza e volume di attività del chirurgo, trattamento delle fratture intracapsulari, fissazione dello stelo femorale in chirurgia protesica, trattamento delle fratture extracapsulari, mobilizzazione e riabilitazione precoce postoperatoria. La popolazione cui la LG si rivolge è rappresentata da soggetti di età > 65 anni di ambo i sessi con diagnosi di FFP, ovvero fratture intracapsulari (composte e scomposte) ed extracapsulari (trocanteriche e sottotrocanteriche). La LG non si applica alla gestione di pazienti con FFP che abbiano un'età ≤ 65 anni e alle fratture di femore causate da patologie specifiche diverse da osteoporosi e osteopenia. Le raccomandazioni contenute nella presente LG sono destinate a tutti gli operatori sanitari a vario titolo coinvolti nell'organizzazione e nel processo di cura dell'anziano con frattura del femore (Medici di Medicina Generale, Chirurghi Ortopedici, Geriatri, Radiologi, Anestesisti, Fisiatri, Fisioterapisti, Infermieri di sala operatoria e di reparto, Direzioni Sanitarie e così via) e a pazienti/cittadini. Al fine di facilitare l'implementazione della LG, per una più rapida consultazione il complesso delle raccomandazioni è riportato nell'Allegato 2 in forma sinottica e in formato *printer friendly*.

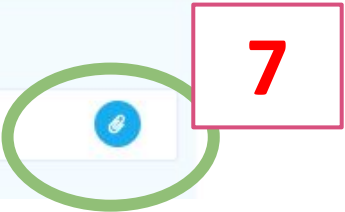



Eating disorders are characterised by preoccupation with weight, shape and calorie balance. Purging, overexercise and preoccupation with body image cause psychosocial and physical harm. Eating disorders typically begin in early to mid-adolescence, but can emerge at any age. The lifetime prevalence of anorexia nervosa in the general population in Western countries is about 1% in women and 0.5% in men. With treatment, around 50% of people with anorexia nervosa achieve full functional recovery. Adolescents have higher rates of full recovery and lower mortality than adults.

Remit and target users

This guideline provides recommendations based on current evidence for best practice in the management of people with eating disorders of all ages and gender groups, in any health or social care setting. Eating disorders covered are:

- anorexia nervosa
- bulimia nervosa
- binge eating disorder
- eating-disordered psychopathology occurring in the context of type 1 diabetes mellitus.



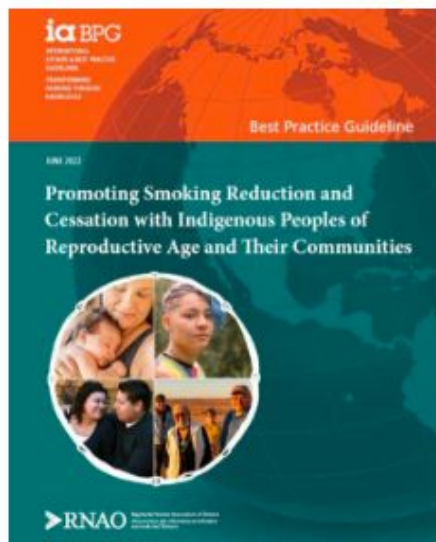
